- * Promoting national autism awareness

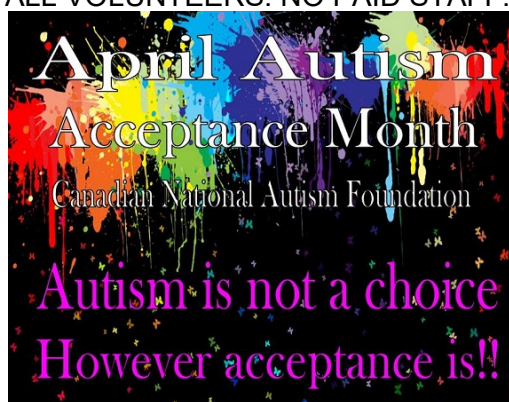
